

We are excited to invite current grantees to host their next event at the Center for Great Purposes, located at the Meyer headquarters.

WHO CAN RESERVE THE CENTER?

Nonprofit organizations with an active Meyer grant are welcome to request a reservation, no more than three months in advance and at least three business days prior to their event.

WHAT KINDS OF EVENTS ARE BEST HOSTED IN THE CENTER?

The space can be set up for general business meetings, retreats or informal events—with maximum capacity ranging between 20 to 100 people depending on the seating configuration.

The space is not suited for formal receptions or events that require outside furniture or equipment rentals.

RESERVATION HOURS

The Center is available Monday through Friday from 9 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. You may access the space up to 30 minutes before and after your reservation time for set up and tear down.

PARKING

Onsite parking is limited. There is one handicap parking spot at the building. Meyer encourages the use of public transportation and ride share services. Secure, indoor bike storage is available.
